Interprofessional cooperation and communication need to be improved to deal with prospective health care challenges. In this context, the education of health professionals is of great importance, since the foundation for the development of basic skills required for an effective interprofessional cooperation is laid at this stage. In contrast to other countries, health universities in Germany have not adequately considered this topic so far. It is only recently that first projects have been developed and curricula as well as educational guidelines have been adjusted. Against this background, our joint project aims to integrate interprofessional topics in health care curricula. To this end, existing best practice examples are collected, evaluated and prepared for a core curriculum for interprofessional cooperation and communication. Furthermore, examination formats and strategies for teacher qualification are being developed and structural factors are being considered in order to support the implementation of the new curriculum
