

Interprofessional Teaching and Learning in the Field of Health Occupations – a Conference by and for young researchers in the education sciences (INFLIGHT)

8 Months (May 2017 – February 2018)

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Summary

The conference focuses on scientific research on interprofessional teaching and learning in the health professions, particularly on the challenges associated with shaping the teaching-learning process and with competence assessment in heterogeneous student groups. On the one hand, the conference aims to bring together for the first time young researchers whose habilitation, doctoral or master theses focus on specific scientific aspects of interprofessional teaching and learning in the field of health professions. On the other hand, we aim to provide young researchers with the opportunity to present and discuss their research projects in moderated research workshops and thus receive informed feedback from both peers and experts in the field.

Moreover, the conference aims to facilitate the identification of thematic and methodological common interests and synergies in this new research field beyond individual stakeholders or location. These common interests and contacts established at this conference lay the foundation for sustainable future networking. In turn, networking is a prerequisite for initiating future research and development collaborations in the field of interprofessional teaching and learning in the health professions.
