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<b>Description:</b>	<p>Interprofessional cooperation and communication have to be improved to deal with prospective challenges in health care. In this context, the education of health professionals has a great importance because basic skills for an effective interprofessional cooperation have already been initiated in this phase. In contrast to other countries, health universities in Germany have not paid any attention to this topic for a long time. Only in recent years, first projects have been developed and curricula as well as educational guidelines have been adjusted. This is the starting point for the joint project. The aim of this project is to integrate interprofessional themes in health care curricula. For this existing, best practice examples are collected, evaluated and prepared for a core curriculum for interprofessional cooperation and communication. Furthermore examination formats are developed. Moreover, concepts for teacher qualification and institutional readiness are drafted to support the implementation.</p>
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
